



The liberation of Kobanî is the liberation of women!

We salute the heroic Kobanî resistance, led by women against the ISIS gang, on its 11th anniversary. Once again, we raise our voices and declare: Kobanî did not fall, and it will never fall.

January 26, 2015—the day Kobanî was liberated—is also the day a free and equal life began to flourish. It marks the historic defeat of the ISIS mentality which targeted women under male-dominated mindset, enslaved and sold them in markets, by the women's freedom struggle.

On that day, the resistance of women in Kobanî—against the gangs that besieged the city from all sides seeking to spread their dark ideology, and against the imperialist powers feeding those gangs—became the very foundation of the Rojava Revolution.

The torture inflicted on the bodies of women fighters resisting this mentality, and the cutting and public display of their hair, are clear proof of their intolerance toward the free and equal life being built under women's leadership in Rojava.

Let it be known that both the cruelty inflicted on women in Kobanî and Rojava, and the women's will that defeated this cruelty, remain vivid and alive in our memory. We will never allow this cruelty to suffocate the Rojava Women's Revolution. We will grow our solidarity with the faith and determination of the women who led the Kobanî resistance.

By raising our international women's struggle, we will not let Kobanî fall. We salute the Kobanî Resistance by declaring that the will of the women who fought against what was imposed on Kobanî eleven years ago, and whose achievements continue to illuminate our struggle, is our will.
